MSF30518 Certificate III in Picture Framing

Overview

A national recognised qualification

This qualification is an industry endorsed credential for people who are currently working in an appropriate work role. This is a practical qualification and assessment tasks focus on a person's work.

Eligibility/entry requirements

This is a practical qualification and assessment tasks are work focused, therefore learners must be working in an appropriate role in industry. In circumstances where it is considered that a learner's language and/or literacy skills may not be at the required level, the language and literacy indicator designed for this qualification will be used to determine whether a learner needs assistance.

Nominal Duration

3 Year Apprenticeship - Participants with industry experience may apply for RPL which may reduce the duration of the course.

Delivery mode

The program will be workplace delivery with the main part of the training conducted under the direct supervision of nominated workplace supervisor and formalized by an RTA Assessor during regular workplace assessment visits.

Training will include workplace projects, activities and on-site assessment and maybe be supported by online learning activities, discussions, tutorials and attendance of industry workshops. Learning is supported by independent research and a range of practical activities.

Assessment

A range of assessment strategies is employed for this training program and the choice of strategy is dependent on the nature of the unit of competency. Strategies include demonstrations, observation, projects, presentations, knowledge tests, reports and interviews.

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Recognition of Prior Learning

Students are able to apply for recognition of prior learning for individual units of competency.

Credit transfer

Units from this qualification that are also contained in other qualifications recognised under the AQF will be recognised for credit transfer purposes.

Entry/exit points

A student may exit from this qualification at any time with a Statement of Attainment for any units of competency completed successfully up to that point.

Resources

Students are issued with learning materials via RTA E-Learning system. E-Books and theoretical assessments are submitted through the learning portal. Internet access and the ability to access and use a computer or mobile device will be required. Where a student may not access the Internet, hard copies of materials can be arranged.

Career pathways

Further training pathways from this qualification may include Certificate IV and Diploma qualifications in the Furnishing Training Package and relevant supervisory, management or competitive manufacturing qualifications.
